



## THERE IS ONLY ONE GOD

**T**here are many religions that claim to have the truth concerning God. Many of these are false! There is only one God, one Lord, and one Creator. Jesus Christ is the only Lord! There is no one else!

### **Acts 4:10-12**

10 Be it known unto you all, and to all the people of Israel, that by the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, whom ye crucified, whom God raised from the dead, even by him doth this man stand here before you whole.

11 This is the stone which was set at nought of you builders, which is become the head of the corner.

12 Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved.

All of the denominations in the world claim to have the truth, but if they do not acknowledge that Jesus Christ is the one and only true God, they are deceiving themselves and you. There is none beside Jesus Christ. There are many religions that claim to have the truth but relegate Jesus Christ to a person. Others totally ignore Jesus Christ and some believe in executing Christians, like the fundamental Muslims. There are many Christians who believe that God is a being divided up into three persons. This does not concur with the Bible that stipulates that God is only one Lord!

### **Deuteronomy 6:1-9**

1 Now these are the commandments, the statutes, and the judgments, which the LORD your God commanded to teach you, that ye might do them in the land whither ye go to possess it:

2 That thou mightest fear the LORD thy God, to keep all his statutes and his commandments, which I command thee, thou, and thy son, and thy son's son, all the days of thy life; and that thy days may be prolonged.

3 Hear therefore, O Israel, and observe to do it; that it may be well with thee, and that ye may increase mightily, as the LORD God of thy fathers hath promised thee, in the land that floweth with milk and honey.

4 Hear, O Israel: **The LORD our God is one LORD:**

5 And thou shalt love the LORD thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy might.

6 And these words, which I command thee this day, shall be in thine heart:

7 And thou shalt teach them diligently unto thy children, and shalt talk of them when thou sittest in thine house, and when thou walkest by the way, and when thou liest down, and when thou risest up.

8 And thou shalt bind them for a sign upon thine hand, and they shall be as frontlets between thine eyes.

9 And thou shalt write them upon the posts of thy house, and on thy gates.

Look at the admonition that Moses gave the children of Israel concerning the deity of God. He admonished Israel that there was no division in the godhead. That God consists of one and only one Lord. Also notice how strongly Moses admonished Israel on this point.

- Thou shalt teach them diligently unto thy children
- Thou shalt talk of them when thou sittest in thine house
- and when thou walkest by the way
- and when thou liest down
- and when thou risest up
- thou shalt bind them for a sign upon thine hand
- they shall be as frontlets between thine eyes
- thou shalt write them upon the posts of thy house, and on thy gates

Moses really admonished Israel that God consisted of only one solitary being. God is not divided up into three distinct persons or beings according to the Bible. The most learned apostle, Paul put it this way:

## **Colossians 2:1-15**

1 For I would that ye knew what great conflict I have for you, and for them at Laodicea, and for as many as have not seen my face in the flesh;

2 That their hearts might be comforted, being knit together in love, and unto all riches of the full assurance of understanding, to the acknowledgement of the mystery of God, and of the Father, and of Christ;

3 In whom are hid all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge.

4 And this I say, lest any man should beguile you with enticing words.

5 For though I be absent in the flesh, yet am I with you in the spirit, joying and beholding your order, and the stedfastness of your faith in Christ.

6 As ye have therefore received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk ye in him:

7 Rooted and built up in him, and stablished in the faith, as ye have been taught, abounding therein with thanksgiving.

8 Beware lest any man spoil you through philosophy and vain deceit, after the tradition of men, after the rudiments of the world, and not after Christ.

**9 For in him dwelleth all the fulness of the Godhead bodily.**

10 And ye are complete in him, which is the head of all principality and power:

11 In whom also ye are circumcised with the circumcision made without hands, in putting off the body of the sins of the flesh by the circumcision of Christ:

12 Buried with him in baptism, wherein also ye are risen with him through the faith of the operation of God, who hath raised him from the dead.

13 And you, being dead in your sins and the uncircumcision of your flesh, hath he quickened together with him, having forgiven you all trespasses;

14 Blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to his cross;

15 And having spoiled principalities and powers, he made a shew of them openly, triumphing over them in it.

Paul knew that the day was coming when deceivers would deceive many into believing that God is a multifaceted three part being. Paul knew that all of the fulness of the godhead was complete in Jesus Christ. He knew that the creator of the entire universe was

Jesus Christ.

## **John 1:1-18**

1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

2 The same was in the beginning with God.

3 All things were made by him; and without him was not any thing made that was made.

4 In him was life; and the life was the light of men.

5 And the light shineth in darkness; and the darkness comprehended it not.

6 There was a man sent from God, whose name was John.

7 The same came for a witness, to bear witness of the Light, that all men through him might believe.

8 He was not that Light, but was sent to bear witness of that Light.

9 That was the true Light, which lighteth every man that cometh into the world.

10 He was in the world, and the world was made by him, and the world knew him not.

11 He came unto his own, and his own received him not.

12 But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name:

13 Which were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God.

14 And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth.

15 John bare witness of him, and cried, saying, This was he of whom I spake, He that cometh after me is preferred before me: for he was before me.

16 And of his fulness have all we received, and grace for grace.

17 For the law was given by Moses, but grace

and truth came by Jesus Christ.

18 No man hath seen God at any time; the only begotten Son, which is in the bosom of the Father, he hath declared him.

Jesus made everything that was made. He is the God who made Adam and Eve. He is the God who walked and talked with Adam in the evening. Jesus is the God who reigned down fire and brimstone upon Sodom and Gomorrah. Jesus Christ is the God who will judge the world along with the end time Babylonian nation.

Those who do not believe with all of their heart that Jesus Christ is the one true God will find themselves being consumed in the lake of fire. There are some Christian ministers who do not believe in repentance. They think that repentance is old fashioned. If it was good enough for Peter then it is good enough for me.

## **Acts 2:38-41**

38 Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.

39 For the promise is unto you, and to your children, and to all that are afar off, even as many as the LORD our God shall call.

40 And with many other words did he testify and exhort, saying, Save yourselves from this untoward generation.

41 Then they that gladly received his word were baptized: and the same day there were added unto them about three thousand souls.

Just as when Peter was preaching to the Jews in Jerusalem and told them to repent and be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ, this same admonition is prudent for us today. Just attending Church without really believing and repenting to the Lord Jesus Christ

asking for his divine forgiveness is not enough. You must repent and seek the forgiveness of the Lord Jesus Christ. You need to seek the Lord with your whole heart, your whole mind, and your whole soul. Only then will you be filled with the Holy Ghost!

What are you waiting for? Jesus is waiting for you to come to him.

Are you ready to seek the Lord Jesus today?

Are you prepared for the coming of the Lord?

If the Lord calls his church home while you are reading this, will you be one of the few who will rise to meet him in the air?

If you have have not been able to answer yes to each of the above questions, or have any doubt about your salvation, now is the time to get down on your knees and repent of all of your sins. Now is the time to seek the Lord Jesus Christ with your whole heart. Now is the time repent and invite the Lord to reside in your heart.
