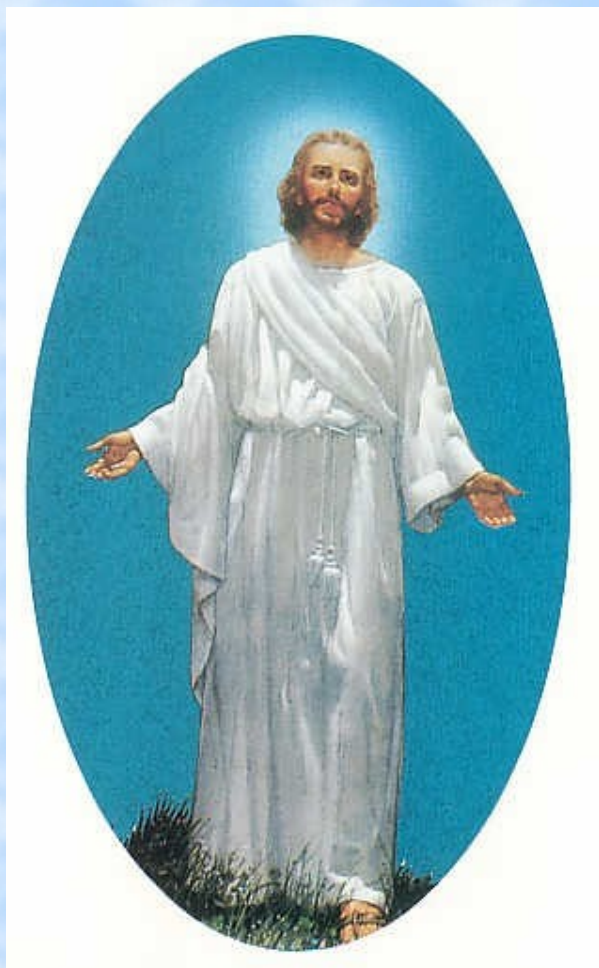

New Perceptions

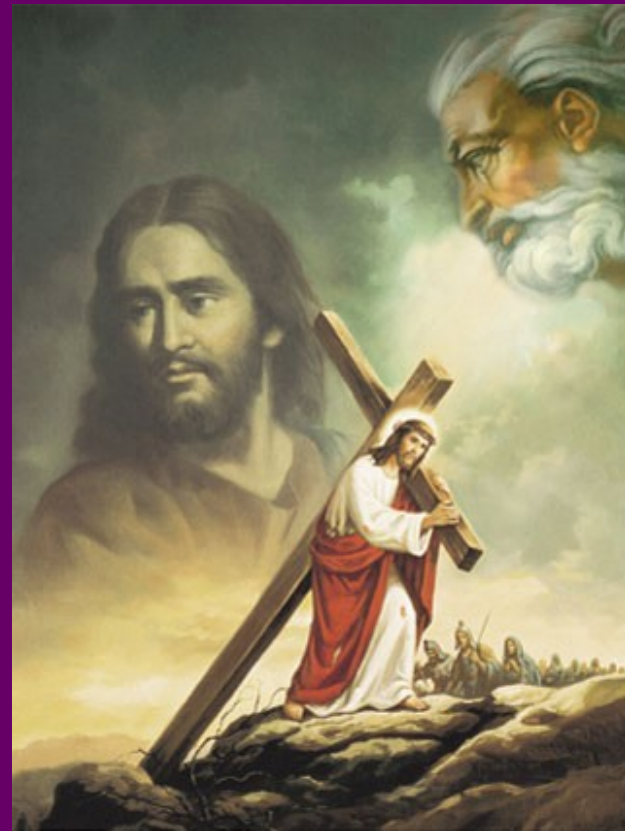
- ★ Born-again Christians do not need a holiday to celebrate the passing of time.

Crucifixion of Jesus Christ
